This renovation at Alderley progressed through a variety of design approaches before arriving at the final outcome. As with most projects, the design process involved finely balancing the programmatic requirements of a growing family within a set budget. The extension has retained most of the existing Queenslander and added 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms and a new kitchen, living room and outdoor room.

The big windows lead a plenty of light into the interior to make space get more natural light. The large extensive use of the wooden floor not only makes people feel that they are close to the nature, but also improves the quality of space. Moreover, the red chairs increase vitality for space.
